

A message from our President....Tiffany Noel


Greetings! I hope that you all have had a wonderful February. It is hard to believe that we are already at the end of February and spring feels like it is officially upon us!


Across Alabama, we are gearing up for the election season in June. The statewide primary election will be on June 5th. Mark your calendars!




We will need members to join us and help with sponsorships, silent-auction items, decorating, and ticket sales. This is a great time to get involved and see how much fun we have!

Board Member Spotlight

This month's board member spotlight is on our Republican Women of Huntsville, President, Ms. Tiffany Noel. Tiffany is a great leader for our club and has a very interesting path that has brought her to us. You may be surprised to learn a few new things about Tiffany!









Tiffany, are you from Huntsville originally and what did you like most about growing up in this area?

TN: I am originally from Huntsville and grew up here attending Madison Academy and Grissom High School. Huntsville has always been a special place. I loved growing up in a NASA family and some of my earliest memories were of Apollo and Shuttle launches that my dad was working on. I grew up in a great church with a very active youth group and loved living in a city where I could ride my bike with my sister to the pool and play outside all day until the street lights came on.

When did you become interested in politics? What sparked this interest?

TN: I was always interested in politics. I come from a very political family. My grandfather was the chairman of the Republican Party in Marshall County and my grandmother was an active member of the AFRW. My dad served for many years as Chairman of the Madison County GOP and my mom was on the RWH Board for many years. I loved politics and grew up around it - but never thought of it as a real job! I have to admit that the election of Bill Clinton was a big factor in becoming more involved in the political process.

When did you become involved with the Republican Women of Huntsville?

TN: I became a member of RWH back in 1994 when I was working on the Wayne Parker for Congress campaign. I remember meetings at the Fogcutter Restaurant when we had much smaller crowds and our President - Kathy Linden - had her children in high chairs.

Outside of the RWH, what is your career and your other hobbies and interests?

I worked briefly in engineering but then moved to DC and worked for twelve years for Congressman Robert Aderholt. I have worked as the District Director for Congressman Mo Brooks since he was elected in 2010. I love my job and enjoy working with Mo and Martha. Outside of my job, I'm on the board of the Huntsville/Madison County Auburn Club and Friends Inc which is a non-profit that offers services to the seriously ill or disabled with caring volunteers. I love to read and travel. I still take several trips a year with my girlfriends that I've known since middle school. I also spend as much time as I can with my family - especially my niece and nephew.

What is something interesting about yourself, that many people may not know?

TN: I spent two summers in college living and working abroad. One summer I lived in Vienna and taught English using the Bible to students at International Christian University. Another summer I lived in Prague and worked for a chemical company through the Auburn University Business school. I also play the piano - but never for anyone else. Just for me! And when I was in elementary and middle school - I was a figure skater. I even won a gold medal in Atlanta once.
